

## PRIVACY POLICY

IDDEX considers the privacy of our clients' data of paramount importance. For this reason we have taken many steps to ensure the privacy of client data including:

Only using highly secure data centers

We will apply each year for a SAS 70, an independent assessment by an internationally recognized audit firm of the integrity of our controls and procedures.

This document outlines the types of organizational and organizational information we register and store when you use the services of IDDEX, as well as some of the steps we take to safeguard information. Please call if you have any questions on any of these policies.

This document summarizes the full IDDEX Privacy Policy, (IDDEX Privacy Policy) which applies to IDDEX and to every active user and Member of the Innovation Manager™ Membership requires signature of an End User License Agreement that includes adherence to this privacy policy and a mutual NDA as a condition of membership.

### **Organizational and other data we collect**

IDDEX collects organizational information when you register for a IDDEX service or otherwise voluntarily provide such information. We may combine organizational information collected from you with information from other IDDEX services or third parties to provide a better user experience, including customizing content for you.

IDDEX may use cookies and other technologies to enhance your online experience and to learn about how you use IDDEX services in order to improve the quality of our services.

IDDEX's servers automatically record information when you visit our website or use some of our products, including the URL, IP address, browser type and language, and the date and time of your request. .

### **Use of Data**

We may use organizational information to provide the services you've requested, including services that display customized content and aggregate statistical information. Aggregate statistical information is information that is recorded about usage of the Innovation Manager system and is collected into groups so that it no longer reflects or references an individually identifiable user.

We may also use organizational information for auditing, research and analysis to operate and improve IDDEX technologies and services but **may not include any of your proprietary information or in any way allow for your proprietary information to be deduced**. If you opt to encrypt any of your data that will not be included even in aggregate statistical review.

In addition you may participate, if you wish, in a program that allows you while keeping your data strictly confidential, will enable you to identify potential licensees, investors or Joint venture partners of your technology based only on key words. Neither your identity

nor confidential information is exposed in any way until you specifically give approval. If you wish this entire feature may be turned off.

When we use third parties to assist us in processing your organizational information, we require that they comply with our Privacy Policy and any other appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

We may also share information with third parties in strictly limited circumstances, including when complying with legal process or preventing fraud or imminent harm, and ensuring the security of our network and services.

IDDEX processes organizational information on our servers in the United States of America and in other countries. In some cases, we process organizational information on a server outside your own country but we will always ensure that it is a jurisdiction that will respect and be able to enforce this privacy policy.

You may decline refuse cookies in your browser, although this may reduce some of the functionality of Innovation Manager.

We make every effort to provide you access to your organizational information upon request and to let you correct such data if it is inaccurate whenever possible.
